1. Student's parent or grandparent must be a ***current*** member of the Knights of Columbus Council #868 (person qualifies if now deceased, but was an active member in K of C at time of death)
2. Student must have at least a 2.0 GPA;
3. Must demonstrate concern for others by turning in at least 20 documented and approved community service hours into the RCHS guidance office;
4. Student must be of sound moral character and a practicing Catholic.
