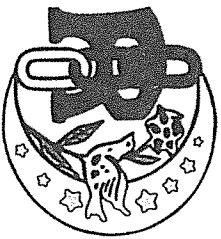
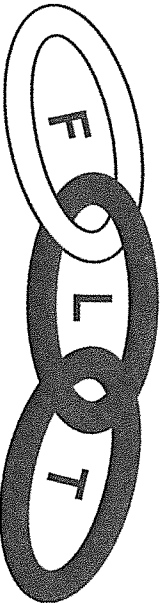

Electronic filing

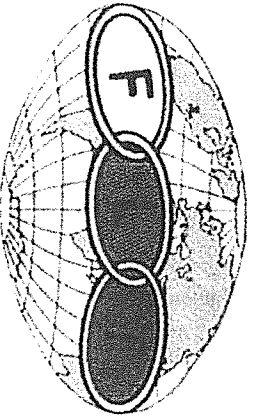

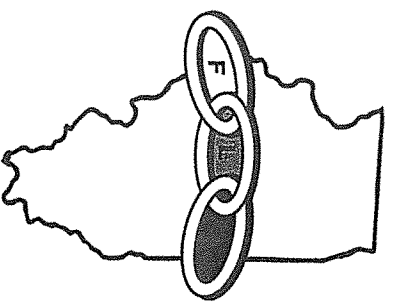
