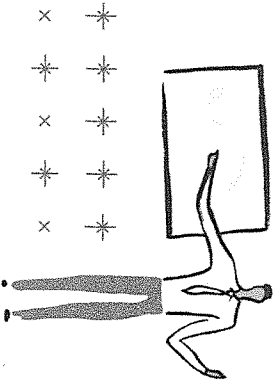

Freshman Academic Scholarship	New full-time undergraduate students; Issued based on GPA & ACT/SAT. See website (quincy.edu/scholarships).	\$7,500-\$25,000 (renewable)
Transfer Academic Scholarship	New Transfer full-time undergraduate students; Issued based on GPA. See website (quincy.edu/transfer).	\$8,000-\$17,000 (renewable)
Franciscan Service Scholarship	New full-time Freshman and Transfer students; 300-500 word essay outlining service to others and the impact experienced by both the student and those served; letter of recommendation noting the student's service dedication; on-campus interview.	\$1,000 (renewable)
Western Catholic Union Scholarship	New full-time Freshman and Transfer students; formal essay outlining the unique value the student brings to Quincy University; recipients must organize a fundraiser or community outreach project with support from their local branch of the Western Catholic Union. Recipients must be of the Catholic faith.	\$2,000 one-year; five recipients (candidates and recipients may reapply each year)
Presidential Scholarship Competition	New full-time Freshman students; minimum 3.4 high school cumulative GPA and 26 ACT / 1240 SAT; acceptance no later than January 26, 2018 in order to participate in the Presidential Scholarship Competition on February 3, 2018.	Full tuition (all 4 years) + \$5,000 room & board stipend; five recipients
Music, Art, Athletic Scholarships	Available at the discretion of faculty/coaches. Ask your Admissions Counselor for more information!	Varies
Legacy Scholarship	New full-time Freshman and Transfer students; a parent, grandparent, or great-grandparent must have graduated from Quincy University.	\$1,000 (renewable)
John Wood CC Scholarship	New Full-time Transfer students; Must be enrolling at Quincy University directly from John Wood Community College.	\$1,000 (renewable)
Phi Theta Kappa	New Full-time Transfer students; Must be a member of Phi Theta Kappa at a community college.	\$2,000 (renewable)
