excited to offer this Youth to Washington Scholarship Program as a replacement to the Youth Day Program.

On the Youth to Washington Tour more than 60 students from Illinois travel to Washington, D.C. and meet Illinois Congressmen, Senators and their staffs, tour historical sites, receive information on career paths, learn about co-ops, make lifelong friends, and meet students from across the U.S. It is a truly remarkable trip sponsored for more than 50 years by U.S. electric and telephone co-ops. Past participants have visited such places as Gettysburg; Arlington National Cemetery; White House; U.S. Capitol Building; Washington Monument; the Newseum, Holocaust and Smithsonian Museums; and the Iwo Jima, Lincoln, Jefferson, Korean War, Vietnam War, World War II, U.S. Marine Corps. and Franklin Delano Roosevelt Memorials.

2018 Youth to Washington Scholarship Program

In 2018 Menard Electric Cooperative will award three college scholarships and one Youth to Washington Tour trip (June 8-15, 2018).

The Awards:

- One \$1,000 scholarship to a 4-year college or university
- One \$500 scholarship to a 2-year community college
- One \$500 scholarship to an accredited technical school
- One winner selected from among scholarship winners for an all-expenses paid trip on the Youth to Washington Tour June 8-15, 2018.

Requirements:

- Applicant must be a high school senior or equivalent, graduating during 2018.
- Applicant's parent/legal guardian must be a Menard Electric Cooperative member with their primary residence or business served by the cooperative.
- Applicant must be available to attend the Youth to Washington Tour June 8-15, 2018.

Application Process:

- Completed applications must be received in our office by 4:30 p.m. on March 1, 2018.

Selection and Award:

- Scholarships are one-year, non-renewable awards to students attending an accredited 4-year college or university, 2-year community college, or accredited technical school.
- Applications will be reviewed by a Menard Electric Cooperative employee for completeness and eligibility.
- Recipients will be chosen by an independent panel of judges engaged in the cooperative business model, however not directly employed by Menard Electric.
- Recipients must enroll as a full-time student in the fall of 2018.
- Scholarships will be paid directly to the recipient after proof of enrollment is provided.
- Winner chosen for the Youth to Washington Tour must make every effort to attend. If, in the case of an emergency, the winner cannot attend, an alternate recipient will be selected.
